### THE POPE'S PRAYER INTENTIONS FOR FEBRUARY

**Universal:** Say "No" to Corruption That those who have material, political or spiritual power may resist any lure of corruption.

**For Vocations:** 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Lent - That those considering a call to the priesthood or consecrated life will answer the call of the Lord unhesitatingly like Abraham, we pray to the Lord.

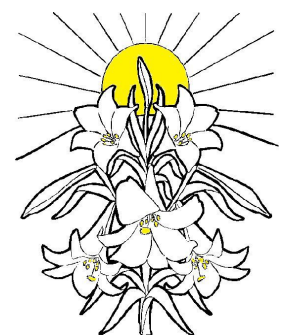
